The Florida State University baseball team moved to its sixth victory of the season here last night by blanking Loyola of the South 7-9 behind the masterful two-hit pitching of Ed Lockard.

The big Jacksonville righthander had a no-hitter going for five innings but his bid-for a hitless win was ruined in the fifth inning when secondosseman Bill Lamey sliced a drive into center and Joe Serpas pumped a one-basser into deep right.

Besides his efforts on the hill. Lockard scored what proved to be the winning run in the sixth inning when he singled to left, advanced to third on an error and spored on a long fly by Captain

Bob Trownridge.

The big blow of the game however came in the Seminole's half of the eighth, when reserve infielder Billy Campbell slapped a tremendous homer into right field that bounded all the way to the wall, scoring Ham Wernke and Lockard.

The Indians had added three more runs in the seventh on two wild pitches, two errors, a single by Les Mullen and Trowbridge's long double to center.

Besides the brief flurry in the sixth. Loyala tried to piece together a raily into the top of the ninth when with one out Lockard issued three straight walks. However, Lockard forced the next two batters to ground out, thereby preserving his shutout.
