

DELAND—Florida State University squeezed out an 11-10 triumph in 10 innings over Stolson here Saturday afternoon to gain an even break in a two-game series with the Hatters.

After a single and two walks had loaded the bases, Marks passed Seminole pitcher Ed Lockard to force in the deciding run.

Lockard weathered a streak of wildness, 10 hits and a seven-run second inning to stagger the route and chalk up the win.

From there on out, however, Lockard settled down and kept Stelson fairly well in check.

After FSU scored five runs in the third and one in the fifth to pull up a 9-6 deficit, Captain Bob Trowbridge put his mates back

Two more runs in the ninth gave the Indians a 10-9 lead, but the Hatters tied up in the bottom of the ninth to force the game into extra innings. Les Mullens, with three singles and three rbis, was the Seminoles' most consistent hitter.

FSU played without the services of veteran Ronald Melton who injured his elbow Friday. Melton is expected back in the lineup Monday when the Seminoles open a two-game series with Tampa U. in Tampa.
