## College Teams Meet Again Tonight

The University of Tampa baseball team will try to square its series with Florida State University at Plant Field at 8 o'clock tonight after dropping the opener to the Seminoles, 7-4, last night.

The Seminoles only made seven hits off Spartan Hurler Ed Peck but bunched them for one run in the first, three in the fifth and three in the sixth. Five Tampa errors also figured in the scoring.

**COTTER MILLS**, Seminole rightfielder, led FSU at the plate, driving in four runs with a single and a double.

Tampa staged a two-run rally in the ninth on singles by Leo Alfonso and Charlie Xiques, an error and George Montz' long lift to right.

**ED SESSIONS**, FSU ace, held the Spartans to six hits, two of them by Johnny O'Neal, who had a single and a double in four official trips to the plate.

The game attracted a crowd of 300 fans with proceeds going to the West Tampa Boys' Club building program. Gate receipts tonight also are tabbed for this worthy cause.

Tampa Coach Marcelo Maseda named Tommy Spicola, senior moundsman, as his starter tonight.
