Ed Sessions threw a four-hitter at the Taxe Park night and though his mates collected only five themselves they were good for a 2-1 triumph.

The first Seminole marker was unearned as Tar hurler Don Talbot made things tougher for himself.

In the first inning lead-off man Cooter Mills worked the count to 3-2 and drew a walk. Mills moved into scoring position when Ralph Blinn was hit by Tauscher. Then Les Mullen bunted to the mound and Tauscher might have had Mills at third but fumbled, then threw wild to first and Mills scored.

The other Indian run was fully earned. Ronald Melton singled off the first-sacker's glove in the sixth inning. Wayne Benner lined one past the right fielder all the way to the 378-foot pole and Melton loped in easily enough, though a good relay from second caught Benner at the plate.

The Tars were powerless at the plate most of the evening but in the seventh they scratched Sessions for a tally. Talbot singled off lanky Ed's glove and went to second on Work's infield out. Helms bounced a single through the middle and the speedy Talbot raced in to score.

The game was probably Sessions' top performance as a Seminole hurler. The tall Tallahassee junior, a former Leon High ace, fanned eight and did not walk a man though he did hit one batter and uncorked a wild pitch.
