The Seminoles committed seven errors, allowed three passed balls, fell asleep in the field, and were not hitting, so it wasn't surprising that the Rollins Tars walked off Centennial Field last night with a 9-2 triumph that earned them a series split with Florida State.

Despite the off night, FSU can still boast a 13-4 won-lost record.

Tar Southerner Bill Cary had plenty on the ball and the Indians helped him by sometimes at bad pitches. They only faintly resembled the smooth-operating club that had set an FSU record for seasonal percentage the night before.

## BIG CLUSTER

Rollins grabbed its big cluster of runs off Ed Lockard in the fourth to send the right hander down to his first college loss of the season. Here's how they did it:

A walk, two passed balls and another free ticket put runners on first and third. Then Don Work sent a bouncer toward short and when third-sacker Ham Wernke crossed in front of short-stop Bob Trowbridge to make the play the ball bounced up and over his glove for a two-base error, one run scoring.

Lockard fanned one man but Al Daynor singled, scoring Talbot, who had walked, and Daynor scored when the ball bounced over centerfielder Les Mullen.

McHardy drove one through Wernke for another error and Daynor came in.

In the eighth frame the Tars first loaded the bases, hit into a double-play on which no one scored, and still managed to tally twice on another FSU error and an ill-advised run-down.

Mullen was the only Indian to show any stickwork; his triple in the sixth sent Ralph Blinn home with one run and Trowbridge skied Mullen in. But it was far from enough to save Lockard from his first loss after six straight wins.
