

The Florida State University baseball team was slated to go after its sixth win of the season and second in as many days this afternoon when it met the Amherst College Lord Jeffs here.

FSU Coach Ralph Matherly was expected to send right-hander George Wehemann of St. Petersburg to the mound in an attempt to make a clean sweep of the Amherst series. The Tribe won yesterday, 5-0, from the barnstorming Massachusetts nine which has been on a swing through Florida.

Wehemann started against Georgia last week, gave up eight hits for two scores in seven innings.

Yesterday the Tribe got superb pitching from Jim Atwood to notch its fifth win against two losses. Making his first start in college ball, the freshman right-hander gave up just five hits, walked only one, and struck out seven. Atwood was never in trouble.

The Seminoles, meanwhile, were tapping a trio of Amherst slingers for 10 hits, including Ralph Blinn's second homer of the season. Blinn sent a drive to the base of the right center field fence in the sixth with one aboard.

Tallahassee's Billy Mills got

two for four for the Tribe to take over the lead in the hitting department. Max Long rapped out two safeties in five trips.

The visitors were unable to muster a serious threat. They failed to get two hits in any one inning. Second-sacker Tom Knight got two of the five Lord Jeff hits.
