It was a wild game that ended in a rhubarb outside the dressing rooms.

Matherly told Winter Park Police Chief Carl Buchanan that umpires Goose Kettles and Allen Mobley were "paid" and demanded that he arrest them. FSU players surrounded the umpires outside the dressing rooms and several dared them to fight, Buchanan said.

Buchanan said "no" to Matherly, ordered the players inside and the incident ended.

FSU players complained throughout the game about umpires' decisions, particularly Kettles' ball and strike calls.

STARTED EARLY

Tempers flared in the first inning when FSU second baseman Billy Campbell tagged Rollins centerfielder Connie Mack Butler on an attempted steal.

In the eighth inning Butler ran into Campbell at first base when Campbell was taking a throw for a force out and the entire squad stormed Mobley in protest. Butler was called out but was not ejected.

Rollins scored all its runs in the eighth. Two walks by pitcher Jim Atwood and pinch hitter Bill Cary's bunt single loaded the bases. Nick Vancho's long fly and Talbot's homer scored four runs.

Florida State scored twice in

the first on three walks by Rollins hurler Bob Leader, an infield single by Campbell and a two-base error.
