

Florida State University was banking on the right hand offerings of either Wally Higginbotham or Ed Lockard today to gain its 10th win of the season as the Tribe went against the Jacksonville Navy nine on the West Campus diamond.

Today's game opens a two-game series. The clubs meet again tomorrow at the same time on the West Campus diamond.

Yesterday FSU won its ninth game of the campaign with a 14-1 drubbing of the University of Cincinnati Bearcats. George Hehemann went the route for the Tribe to gain his second win. Hehemann gave up just six blows, walked only three, fanned three.

The Seminoles continued to show increased power at the plate. They jumped on a trio of Cat chunkers for 11 hits, including triples by Ralph Blinn, Billy Campbell, and Bob Hudson. Five Indians gathered two hits apiece. They were Billy Mills, John Cuesta, Hudson, and Blinn.

The Seminoles scored in every inning except the eighth. They pushed across two in the first, three in the second, and four in the third to take a commanding 9-0 lead.

The Bearcats, showing the effects of having played only one previous game, committed five errors and were inept at the plate.

In all five batters were hit by pitched balls.

A hard wind blowing in from the left field made easy outs of some hard hit drives to the fields.
