

Looking for a clean sweep of the series over Jacksonville Navy and victory No. 11 of the season, Florida State University baseball Coach Walter Matherly was expected to send either senior Ed Lockard or freshman Wally Higginbotham to the hilltop against the Fliers today.

The game was slated at 2:30 at the West Campus diamond, scene yesterday of a fancy 4-2 win by the Seminoles' lone left-hander, Chuck Sanders.

Sanders spaced out six blows over an equal number of innings, fanned five and walked only two in hurling FSU to its 10th win against five losses and a tie.

And, when a hit was needed to break a 2-2 tie in the sixth frame, it was Sanders who supplied it, driving rightfielder Gary Ashley across the plate after Ralph Blinn had singled Bob Hudson in with the tying marker.

The Seminoles later got an insurance run off the Ellers Clarence Ellerson in the seventh on a single by Ashley and three walks—the last one of the string going to Blinn:

Both teams scored one in the first frame, catcher Bob Horne scoring Tom Neely with an infield out for the Fliers, and Johnny Cuesta singling Capt. Billy Mills in for the Indians.

It was Horne and Neely who gave the Navy its short-lived lead in the fifth, with the catcher's long fly to left riding the second sacker across.

Double plays helped both hurlers out of bad holes in a couple of frames. Ellerson also went the route, yielding 10 hits—all singles—walking seven and whiffing one.

Five of the Fillers are property of big league teams. Shortstop Lucky Luttrell and Horne having played at Orlando and Charlotte in the Washington chain. Neely and Jim Coughlin have labored in the Chicago Cub and New York Yank organizations and Mat Woloszn is the property of the St. Louis Cards.
