It's still a good five months before the 1953 football season opens, but Florida State University's Tom Nugent might do well to start planning today how to stop a fellow named John Imgrund, when the Seminoles and the Stetson Hatters clash here next fall.

This Imgrund guy has turned into a one-man Seminole stopper. The versatile Florida traveler—he hails from West Orange, N. J.

—staged a one-man show against FSU in the District 25 NAIA basketball final last March. Imgrund, a unanimous selection on the All-Florida cage dream team, pitched in 25 points to personally end the Seminoles' season.

Imgrund was at it again Friday. Pitching baseballs this time, Imgrund blanked Coach Ralph Matherly's Indians on six hits, in a thriller at Centennial Field.

The big, blond was rated as the No. 1 quarterback prospect in Stetson's spring grid drills. That means he'll be chunking footballs at the Seminoles next fall.

Friday's issue was settled in the first inning, when Stetson pushed across an unearned run in the first-inning, to spoil freshman right-hander Max Long's bid for his third victory. The run came on singles by John Bertzel and Fred Eubeler and an infield error.
