FSU Tops Vols, Bows To Tigers

Auburn's Tigers clustered all their runs in two big innings to hand Florida State its first collegiate baseball loss, 7-2, yesterday, after the Seminoles had saddled the Tennessee Vols with a 7-4 setback.

An estimated 500 fans watched the six-hour double-header at FSU's East Campus diamond.

Sophomore pitcher Jim Atwood of Hollywood and soph catcher Gary Ashley of Greenville, S. C., steered the Seminoles to their win over Tennessee.

Atwood, wearing a bandage over his right eye as a result of a collision with a bat a week ago, scattered seven hits in a six-inning relief role to get his first decision. Ashley was the plate star, bagging a double and two singles in five trips.

BELCHER SMASH

Vol Shortstop Ted Belcher put his name in the record book by belting the first home run over the wire fence bordering the spacious outfield. Belcher's homer was a 330-foot shot over the right-center wall.

Captain Bob Hudson smacked an inside-the-park homer good for two runs against the Vols.
