Three Florida State University pitchers got major league fielding support from their teammates here yesterday as the Seminoles stopped Tampa's Spartans, 7-2.

The win gave FSU a sweep of its week-end series with Tampa, which was coopered by a 13-1 margin Friday,

Yesterday's same, interrupted for 20 minutes by rain, was highlighted by Seminole first baseman Fred Twomey's first home run of the season. Twomey belted a fast ball over the 350foot left centerfield fence with the bases empty in the fifth inning to become the third collegiate player to hit one out of FSUs new park.

Tennessee shortstop Ted Belcher and FSU outfielder Bob Hudson previously had smacked homers over the 330-foot right field wall.

Coach Ralph Matherly, in a pre-game moment, decided to use three pitchers yesterday and the choice proved a wise one. George Hehemann, Bobby Waits and Max Long teamed to check the Spartans on eight hits. The losers bunched four of them for their two runs in the sixth inning. Hehemann, the starter, was the winner, notching his second victory against no setbacks.

The Seminole infield—Carlee Hendrix at third, Cooter Mills at short, Billy Campbell at second, and Twomey at first—turned in several sparkling plays on slowhit rollers. Mills turned three tough chances into putouts.

Twomey was the plate star, bagging a single besides his homer.

The Seminoles had a much easier time against Tampa Friday, when Big Jim Atwood limited the Spartans to four singles. It was the first route-going performance for Atwood this season. Twomey and Campbell led

FSU's 12-hit barrage Friday with three hits apiece.
