

With a home-opening 17-3 victory over Furman under their belts, Florida State's Seminoles hoped to continue their productive run-making in a doubleheader baseball attraction at Centennial Field this afternoon.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's undefeated Indians, winners of three games, clashed with Furman in the first game at 1 and were scheduled to meet LSU in the 4 p.m. second game. Tommy Garcia and John Ash were ticketed to pitch for FSU.

Tallahassee Mayor H. C. Summitt was due to throw out the first ball of the twin bill.

#### SCORE EVERY INNING

Scoring in every inning, FSU hammered two Furman pitchers for 17 hits in yesterday's 17-3 rout. Junior Max Long, winning his second game, and George Hehemann allowed Furman only four hits and three unearned runs.

First-baseman Fred Twomey sparked the Seminole attack with a three-run homer in the first inning. Twomey, reporting late because of basketball, belted Al Kyber's first pitch over the 360-foot left-centerfield wall at FSU's East Campus diamond.

Eleven Seminoles shared in the 17-hit assault, with Twomey getting a triple besides his four-bagger, and five others collecting two hits apiece.

The Seminoles have now scored 36 runs in 25 innings, 32 in the last 16 frames. Litwhiler

continued to move the Seminoles around the bases, with third baseman Carlee Hendrix getting two stolen sacks.

Four FSU errors paved the way for Furman's three unearned runs.

Long struck out seven and gave up three hits over the first six innings. Hehemann mopped up, striking out the side twice and giving up one single in the three innings he worked.
