WINTER PARK—Freshman pitcher Tommy Garcia won his fifth straight game as Florida State jumped on Rollins ace Bill Cary for 11 hits and a 7-2 Florida Intercollegiate Conference baseball triumph here yesterday.

It was State's third success in as many games on the road and

jumped the Seminoles' season record to 11-3. The teams close a two-game series today with either Jim Adwood (1-0) or Max Long (2-2) set to do the FSU pitching.

Garcia, first-year sensation from Fort Myers, was touched for nine hits by the 1954 NCAA finalists. But two double plays and some neat clutch pitching pulled him out of the tight spots.

Garcia is now the state's leading collegiate hurler, with a spotless 5-0 mark. The 5-7, 160-pounder has yielded only four earned runs in 39 innings.

FIRST SETBACK

Five Seminoles shared in the 11-hit attack on Rollins left-hander Cary. It was the Cary's first 1955 setback after three triumphs. Shortstop Pfil Hunt solved Cary for three singles and Ham Wernke, Jim Barton, Twomey, and Garcia had two hits apiece.

Rollins took a one-run lead in the second inning but FSU rallied for four in the third to ice the game. A two-run double by Twomey, FSU's runs-batted-in leader with 18 in 12 games, highlighted the explosion.
