more in the sixth, and continued s with two in the seventh and eighth against the third FSU hurler, Frank Slusser.

A rash of errors bobbled the Seminoles. Third baseman Carliee Hendrix came up with three miscues to lead the way as the Tribe bobbled 11 chances in the field.

Wisconsin's John Demerit, the home-run hitting star in the recently concluded Florida State Invitational tournament, was the leading hitter for the Badgors with three hits in five times at bat.

The Badgers' John Schacte had the Seminoles completely at bay, limiting Coach Danny Litwh.ler's Usifally potent stickmen to three scattered hits.

The game was played before a sparse crowd of 250 in cool weather. The exhibition series will end tonight.

U.W. Hurlers Give 2 Hits

—Wisconsin's baseball team
gained a measure of revenge
for two recent defeats at the
hands of Florida State by
trouncing the Seminoles,
10-3, here Friday night.

Brilliant pitching by Norb Schachte and Pat Cvengros plus 11 errors by the losers propelled the Badgers to the easy conquest. The pair of Wisconsin hurlers handcuffed the Seminoles on two hits as a four-run outburst in the sixth frame broke the game wide open.

Schachte, the tall Madison righthander, gave one hit during the first 4½ innings, and Cvengros, an Ironwood, Mich., product, allowed one more hit the rest of the way. Both Florida State blows were singles.

The Badgers play the same opponent here tonight in the wind-up game of their Florida spring training junket. They plan to fly back to Madison Sunday.

Coach Art (Dynie) Mansfield's boys collected 12 hits off a trio of Florida State moundsmen, including three by Walter Holt and two apiece for Wayne Kelliher, John DeMerit and Ken Townsend. Kelliher, like Schachte, is a former Madison Central prep player.

Singles by Bill Rubin and De-Merit plus an error got Wisconsin off to a one run start in the opening inning. Two errors and Holt's single sent in two more tallies in the third. The Badgers moved ahead, 4-3, in the fifth on Townsend's hit following a single by Holt and his theft of second.

Four runs in the sixth iced the victory as Wisconsin filled the sacks on a single by Schultz, a walk plus an error. DeMerit then singled in two markers. Holt doubled in another, and Kelliher singled in the fourth tally.

The Badgers loaded the bases again in the seventh, allowing Jerry Mattson, a pinch hitter, to single home their last two counters.
