University of Georgia right hander Dan Cabaniss handed Florida State its first shutout of season at Centennial Field Monday night, 2-0, limiting the Seminoles to five scattered hits.

It looked like the Seminoles might pull it out in the bottom of the ninth, when with two out and Dick Howser on first, first baseman Fred Twomey lashed a double down the left-field line but Howseh was caught in a rundown between third and home and tagged out after a strong throw from left.

MEET AGAIN TODAY
