STATESBORO, Ga. — Florida State's Seminoles won their 21st baseball game of the season here last night, defeating Georgia Teachers 5-3.

A fine vitching duel between FSU's Tony Avitable and GTC's Bob Alewine was blasted wide

open by the Seminole heavy artillery in the 6th inning when shortstop Dick Howser and catcher John Sheppard blasted tremendous home runs.

LEADS WITH HOMER

Howser poled a 3-2 pitch over the left field wall to lead off the inning. Then, with two out, Bob

Rosell strolled and Pill Hunt beat out an infield hit.

Sheppard, playing in his second game for the Seminoles this season, blasted a 400-foot drive all the way over the light pole in left field to drive in three more tallies and put the Seminoles in front to stay.

Two hits and two walks gave the Teachers two runs in the third inning, and the Profs picked up another in the eighth on a walk, double and infield out.

The loss by Alewine was his second of the season, both coming at the hands of Florida State. He has won six games.

The Seminoles wind up their season at home May 11 and 12 against Rollins in an important series that will have a great deal of bearing on this district's independent representative at the NCAA playoffs in Gastonia, N. C. in June,
