

DUKE'S BLUE DEVILS POUNCED YOKING STATE 7-1 LAST NIGHT
 night throwing the finish of FSU's Invitational Baseball Tournament into a three-way tie between Duke, FSU and Michigan State.

All three teams finished with 4-2 marks to share the tourney title, while Yale was 0-4. Yesterday afternoon, Michigan State battered Yale, 17-8, to stay in the first place battle.

The Blue Devils hopped on Seminole fireballer Jerry Boxer early in the night contest and pushed five of their runs across in the first two frames. Boxer's wildness helped.

AN EARLY ERROR

A single by Bernie Blaney, a walk to John Morris and an error

by Seminole firstsacker Fred Twomey on Andy Cockrell's grounder let in the first Duke tally in the top of the first.

Coach Ace Parker's charges exploded for four in the second inning, wrapping it up for all practical purposes, as Dick Burton and Harleigh Patzinger proved too tough for FSU batters.

Bill Domhoff, playing for departed Dave Sime, opened the frame with a double, catcher Bob Weltzman singled him to third, and a fielder's choice play on Burton's grounder let in Domhoff with the second run.

Blaney then banged his second straight single, and—with two down—Boxer walked Pete Maynard, the tournament's Most Valuable Player, to fill the bases.

A passed ball let Burton in, and when Maynard attempted to steal second Johnny Sheppard's throw went in to center field, allowing Blaney to score and make it 4-0.

WILD PITCH HELPS

Maynard stole third on the next pitch and Boxer wild pitched him across to give Duke a comfortable 5-0 lead.

Burton went to the plate in the third frame for the Blue Devils and the Seminole pitcher walked him, singled off a batter, and scored only run in the sixth frame. Patzinger on singles by Sheppard and pinch hitter Billy Weaver and a fielder's choice.

All of Duke's runs in the sixth were unearned. The already hot to reliever John Ash's wildness. Ash walked three men in the seventh.
