

Florida State's baseballers almost literally walked past Ithaca College yesterday afternoon, 21-4.

Four Ithaca pitchers surrendered 19 bases, on balls to the Seminoles and the Tribe sandwiched them around 17 base hits to achieve their ninth victory of

the season as against three losses.

Seminole coach Danny Litwhiler cleared his bench in the late stages of the three-hour marathon, throwing 21 men into the game.

Junior right hander Frank Slusser started and gave up two runs in the first five frames to gain the victory.

He was followed to the hill by senior fireballer Jerry Boxer, and sophomores Al Zyla and Don Axon. Zyla and Axon were both making their first appearances of the season.

Every man who batted in the first got on base, one way or another, some on fielder's choice. The Seminoles jumped on starter Bob Graham for four initial runs, on three hits, four walks. Riley Seevera drove in, two of them with a single.

The Tribe continued to score in clusters, crossing the plate five times in the second, thrice in the third and exploding for a nine-run fifth, when 13 men batted in.

Altogether, seven men, including pitcher Slusser got two hits each for the Seminoles. Seven different men also drove in two runs apiece. Nobody drove in three.

By the start of the sixth, all of the Seminole starters were out of the lineup and off to the showers. Litwhiler used 11 sophomores in the contest, many besides Zyla and Axon playing for the first time.

Friday night, the Seminoles resume baseball relations with the University of Florida, whom they lost to 7-5 last night. The two teams will meet Saturday afternoon also.
