**STATESBORO, Ga., April 20**—Florida State baseball team defeated Georgia Teachers College here today, 8-3, for a sweep of the two-game series with the professors.

The Seminole triumph gave FSU a 14-4 record for the season, and Coach Danny Litwhiller's team has

become a strong contender for District III NCAA playoff consideration in June.

FSU's ace lefty, John Bristol, hurled two-hit ball at the Teachers while his mates jumped on GTC hurler Jim White for 12 safeties.

Outfielder Lee Corso and shortstop Dick Howser continued to be the big guns in the Seminole attack. Corso garnered three hits in four trips to the plate, as did Howser.

For the fourth straight game Howser's booming bat signalled his emergence from an early season slump. The smooth little shortstop, who led the team in batting in 1956 with a .422 average, poled his second straight homer plus a double and single to boost his average close to the .300 mark. Prior to the last four games, Howser's average was a slim .220.

The Seminoles got single runs in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th innings, added two more in the sixth, and iced the victory with one in the eighth and two more in the ninth.

GTC, now 10-6 for the season, got a run in the fourth and added two more in the eighth on a walk to catcher Joe Berryhill and outfielder Bob Morrow's home run.

The Seminoles play Auburn in Auburn Monday and Tuesday before returning to Tallahassee. The Tribe will wind up the 1957 season with a lengthy road trip the last of the month against Miami, Florida Southern and Rollins.
