Fleet centerfielder Owen Mc-Carron led in base hits with 35, and fell just two short of tying the school record of 38 in a season, set last year by Howser.

On the pitching side, the Tribe's two mound aces Jerry Boxer (6-2) and Jack Bristol

(6-1) won 12 of the 19 Seminole victories.
