GAINESVILLE—Bernie Parrish picked up yesterday where he left off Friday, slamming a two-run first-inning home run to start Florida on its way to an 8-1 triumph over Florida State.

Parrish, the junior second baseman who will captain the Gator football team next fall, hit a last-inning home run Friday to beat the Seminoles, 8-7.

Yesterday's game was far different from Friday, when the Seminoles whacked 15 hits only to lose on the third pitch in the last of the ninth.

Gator sophomore Ray Oestricher spaced seven Seminole hits yesterday in winning his third straight triumph without a loss.

The loser was Tommy Garcia, victim of Parrish's one-out home run over the left field wall in the first inning. Parrish went hitless the rest of the day, but the Seminoles couldn't muster any big threats against Oestricher.

The Gators had stacked up an 8-0 margin before a walk to shortstop Dick Howser, Jerry Philp's single, and an error gave the Seminoles their only run. Oestricher had blanked Georgia Tech on two hits in his last outing.

Centerfielder Owen McCarron was the only Seminole to reach the Orlando righthander for more than one hit. Leftfielder Charlie Smith collected three of Florida's 10 hits.

It was Florida's 10th victory against two losses to Miami. Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles have a 6-4 record and face Miami's tough Hurricanes in a two-game series

in Tallahassee this Friday and Saturday.
