

Miami's Hurricanes blew a five-run lead, then shoved across seven unearned runs in the ninth to salvage the finale of a two-game series with Florida State, 12-7, here yesterday.

The Miami triumph came less than 24 hours after FSU's Frank Slusser pitched the first no-hitter in Seminole history in an 18-0 State rout of Miami.

CRUCIAL SERIES

The loss leaves Danby Litwhiler's Seminoles with an 8-5 record and facing a crucial two-game series at Auburn this week. Whitey Campbell's Hurricanes are 11-8 for the season.

It looked like Florida State would make it a series sweep yesterday after three rallies overcame a 5-0 Miami lead. But three costly errors and timely Miami hitting opened the gate for seven ninth-inning runs off Jack Bristol and Tommy Garcia.

Bristol deserved a better fate. The senior lefthander came on in the second inning after Miami chased started Fred Kenney with a five-run outburst in the open-inning frame. He blanked the 'Canes from the second through the eighth, but three Seminole miscues cost him the game in the ninth.

It was Bristol's second setback against two victories. Bristol has given up only eight earned runs in 37 innings, with unearned runs costing him both defeats.

HEAVY HITTING

Miami's Vic Stenson survived some heavy Seminole clouting to post his seventh triumph in eight decisions. FSU reached Stenson for 13 hits—including three apiece by leftfielder Jerry Philp and rightfielder Mike Copps—and Dale Koch added a double off reliever Maury Guttman in the ninth.

Philp blasted his third home run in the first inning, a two-run, 360-foot shot over the right-center fence. Miami's Al Dangel socked a three-run homer off Garcia in the ninth. The Hurricanes collected 13 hits in all.
