AUBURN, Ala.—Florida
State's Frank (No-Hit)
Slusser served up a home
run pitch to Auburn leadoff batter L. F. Lanier, then
blanked the Tigers the rest
of the way as the Seminoles racked up a 5-1 triumph here yesterday.

Slusser, the undefeated senior righthander from Nescopek, Pa.,

set the Plainesmen down on five hits for his fourth straight victory. It was State's ninth triumph after five defeats.

The teams were to wind up the two-game series today with FSU's Jack Bristol (2-2) facing Auburn's Alan Koch (5-9).

After Lanier's leadoff homer, Slusser didn't allow an Auburn runner to get past second base. He struck out seven and walked none.

Slusser now has allowed only four earned runs in 38 innings

this spring for a brilliant 0.95 earned run average. He has given up only two runs in the last 27 innings.

While Slusser was taming the Tigers, his teammates jumped on Auburn's Quineth (Red) Roberts for nine hits, handing the promising Auburn sophomore his first loss in five decisions.

Seminole rightfielder Mike Copps drove in the tying run with a sacrifice fly in the fourth. In the sixth, Copps plated another Seminole run and raced all the way home when centerfielder Lanier misjudged his single for a three-base error.

State scored its final two runs in the eighth, on leftfielder Jerry Philp's single, catcher Bill Westendick's double, and third baseman Dale Koch's two-run single to center.

Philp, Koch, and centerfielder Own McCarron led FSU's ninehit attack with two hits apiece. McCarron also stole his 13th base of the season, leaving him only one shy of tying the school record. The Seminoles swiped four bases in all.

Auburn rightfielder Shot Johnston was hit in the head with a pitched ball in the fourth and was taken to the Auburn infirmary. His condition was not believed serious.
