DELAND — Lefthander Jack Bristol scattered five hits as Florida State pounded out a 9-1 victory over Stetson here yesterday to sweep a two-game series.

FOURTH WIN

Bristol went the distance, gaining his fourth victory against two setbacks. He struck out seven and walked seven.

It was the Seminoles' sixth win in a row and gives them an overall record of 14-5. Stetson now has a 9-10 mark.

The game was scoreless until the fourth inning when the Seminoles pushed across two runs on two hits, a walk, two stolen bases and a Stetson error.

FSU jumped on the Hatters' Russ Sikes for seven more tallies in the fifth. Dick Howser's two-run triple and Bristol's double sparked the scoring outburst. The Seminoles banged out a total of four hits and received four walks in the decisive inning.

Stetson's only run off Bristol came in the bottom of the fifth when they loaded the bases with no one out. Two singles, a walk and a sacrifice fly by leftfielder Ray Henry scored shortstop Buddy Weaver. Bristol then retired the side.

LEADING HITTER

Bristol was also FSU's leading hitter with three safeties, two singles and a double, and drove in one run. Howser had a single and triple and knocked in two runs.

The Seminoles continued to harass the opposition with their running, stealing eight bases against the Hatters. Catcher Bill Westendick stole three and Howser two.

FSU continues its four-game road trip with a two-game series at Miami next week. The Seminoles attempt to stop the Seminoles but only one, Fred Roberts, was effective. He planked the noles open the series Monday with Tom Garcia (2-1) slated to handle the mound chores.

Frank Slusser (6-0), who threw a no-hitter against the Hurricanes in Tallahassee April 18, will start Tuesday's game. The Hurricanes and Seminoles split the two-game series in Tallahassee.
