

First baseman Charlie Rodgers smacked a two-run pinch homer with one out in the last of the ninth to give Florida State a 10-8 verdict over Camp Lejeune's Marines here yesterday.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles also took the first game of the exhibition double-header, 11-3.

Junior rightfielder Neil Martin paced FSU's first-game attack with a single, double, and triple. Bill Westendick of Tallahassee belted a three-run home run.

In the second game, the Marines pushed across a run in the top of the ninth to tie the score at 8-8. With one out in the Seminoles' half, pinch-hitter Doug Walker singled to right to set the stage for Rodgers' game-winning pinch home run over the right field wall.

Jim Daniel and Ron Fraser tamed the Marines on five hits in the first game. Don Axon, Al Zyla, and Rick Madison worked the second game.
