

Florida State's heavy-hitting baseball nine reached a season high in hits and runs in taking a one-sided 17-0 victory over Stetson here yesterday.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's Tribe, 7-1 for the season, was set to conclude the two-game series with the Hatters at 3:30 this afternoon on the FSU campus.

The Seminoles scored in all but one inning and collected 16 hits off three Stetson pitchers yesterday. Second baseman Bob Clem continued his hitting streak with a single, double, and triple in four trips. The Atlanta sophomore is hitting .526 for the season.

Tallahassee sophomore Jack Dull, who plays both the outfield and shortstop, slammed his third home run and had five runs-batted-in. Third baseman Gene McCormick and outfielder John Slaton had perfect days with three hits in as many appearances.

Right-hander Frank Davis checked Stetson with six hits over seven innings to gain his second triumph. Al Zyla worked two hitless relief innings. The Hatters put men on second and third in both the third and fourth innings, but couldn't score.

Davis, promising Miami sophomore, struck out seven and didn't issue a walk.

In eight games, FSU has scored 28 runs for an even 11-run

average. Seminole opponents have scored 30 runs.

Sophomore Jim Daniel (0-1) of Atlanta was scheduled to pitch against Stetson today. The Seminoles join North Carolina, Illinois, and Florida in opening FSU's fourth invitational tournament at Centennial Field Thursday.
