

The Seminoles got their third straight shutout, this time by right-hander Frank Davis, in whitewashing Michigan, 11-0, in last night's second game. Sophomore Davis scattered seven Wolverine hits in nothing his fourth triumph against no defeats.

In the meantime, the Seminoles racked up 14 hits against four Michigan hurlers, scoring seven runs in a big fourth inning. Outfielders Neil Martin and John King led the Tribe with three hits each.

The double victory moved FSU's tourney record to 6-3 and its season mark to 14-4. Western Michigan is 4-2 in the tourney, Michigan 1-5.

Ray Flath's 10th-inning home run gave Western Michigan its 9-7 extra-inning verdict over Michigan. Michigan third baseman Dave Brown belted two home runs and first baseman Bill Roman one in the free-hitting game. Western Michigan bagged 17 hits, four by right-hander Len Grabowski.

Duke upped its tourney record to 3-4 with its 13-8 nod over Michigan State. Back-to-back home runs by outfielder Pete Maynard and first baseman Charles Dunlevy in the first inning gave Duke an early start. Catcher Art Browning had three hits for Duke.
