

Florida tagged previously unbeaten, righthander Bob Fraser for five hits on his first eight pitches and went on to dump Florida State 9-7, in the rubber game of their 1959 baseball rivalry here yesterday.

The two-run triumph gave Dave Fuller's Gators a sweep of the weekend series. Florida won Friday night's clash, 6-3, after FSU had trimmed the Gators, 8-7 here two weeks ago.

FIVE STRAIGHT

First baseman Perry McGriff's leadoff double and four straight singles doomed Fraser yesterday. The lean senior had won three in a row.

The Gators scored four runs in that hit-happy first and never trailed, although Danny Litwhiler's Tribe whittled an 8-1 deficit to 8-7 after eight innings. The victory went to starter Ray Oestricher, who gave up eight hits and six runs in the six-plus innings he worked.

Leftfielder Charlie Smith and third baseman Mickey Ellenburg had three hits apiece in Florida's 13-hit barrage. One of Smith's safeties was a leadoff homer in the fifth.

Seminole second baseman Bob Clem boosted his fat batting average to .509 with a double and three singles in five trips. The sophomore has bagged 27 hits in 53 at-bats.

Rightfielder Neil Martin smacked a leadoff home run in the fifth, his first of the season, and shortstop Jack Dull powered a two-run homer, his fourth, in the same inning.

FSU SCORING

Oestricher wild pitched FSU's first run home in the third. Then Martin and Dull home runs accounted for three in the fifth and the Tribe added two in the sixth on first baseman Charlie Rodgers' triple, two walks, and Clem's third straight hit.

Clem's double and a single by leftfielder Doug Walker capped FSU's scoring in the eighth.

In the throes of a three-game losing streak, FSU has a 14-7 season record. Florida is 6-5 for the year. The Seminoles meet Florida Southern in a two-game series at Lakeland next weekend.
