LAKELAND—First baseman Chuck Anderson squeezed home the winning run with one out in the last of the 12th inning to give Florida Southern a 2-1 victory over Florida State yesterday.

The triumph was Florida Southern's first over FSU since 1953 and snapped an 11-game winning string for the Seminoles over the Moccasins

The teams were scheduled for the series finale today, with junfor Duni Nelson (0-1) set to pitch for Danny Litwhiler's Tribe,

Anderson's 12th-inning bunt broke up a dandy pitching dual between FSU's Frank Davis, a righthander, and Southern lefthander Brad Dinsmore.

The Mocs took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on two errors and Ron Buccarill's single, FSU tied it in the third when Davis walked, was forced at second by Bob Clem Neil, Martin walked, and third baseman Dale Koch singled home Clem,

That was all the scoring until the third-extra inning. Catcher Bill Mack lived on an error and moved to second on rightfielder Jack Garrison's single. A passed ball advanced both runners so Davis intentionally walked Buccarelli—his only walk of the game—to load the bases with flone out.

Pinch-nitter Roy Mundy bounced to Charlie Rodgers at first, who fired the ball to the plate to force Mack. But Anderson crossed up the Seminoles by bunting a no-ball, two-strike count to squeeze home the deciding run.

Dinsmore tamed the Tribe on five hits, walking six and fanning 13. It was a tough setback for Davis (4-2), who gave up 12 hits but was tough in the clutch. Davis walked only one. and fanned six.
