

Florida State's baseball team gained its 15th victory of the season, defeating Georgia Teachers, 7-1, on the six-hit pitching of Frank Davis here yesterday.

A sophomore righthander from Miami, Davis struck out 10 and walked only two in posting his fifth win against two losses. The Professors' only run was unearned.

Tallahassee's Jack Dull got the Seminoles off to a good start

by belting his fifth home run of the season, a 340-foot drive, in the first inning.

Dull's two-run blast gave the sophomore shortstop the club RBI leadership with 23.

The Seminoles added two more runs in the third inning.

Neil Martin led off with a triple to center and scored on first baseman Charlie Rodgers' single to right.

Second baseman Bob Clem, the club's leading hitter, got on by a fielder's choice, moved to second on Dull's single to short center, stole third, and scored on an infield out.

The Tribe made it 4-1 with a run in the fourth. Ray Bazzell, Panama City Junior, was hit by a pitched ball by the Professor. He advanced on Davis' sacrifice and moved to third on a wild pitch. Moore's second wild pitch sent Bazzell home.

An error and a triple by Clem gave the Seminoles a run in the sixth.

Georgia Teachers got their run off Davis in the eighth inning. A walk to center fielder Ben Benton was followed by Rodgers' two base throwing error that moved Benton to third. Ralph Barryhill, Prof catcher, hit a ground-rule double to score Benton.

The Seminoles completed the scoring with a run in the bottom of the seventh. With two out, Bill Westendick of Tallahassee beat out an infield hit and scored on Bazzell's double to deep center.

The Seminoles, now 15-8, meet Tampa's Spartans tomorrow at Seminole Field in their final home appearance. The single game begins at 3:30.
