

STATESBORO, Ga.—Georgia State Teachers came from behind to defeat FSU, 5-4, in a baseball game here yesterday.

This was the first time in six years the Georgia club had defeated the Seminoles.

Georgia Teachers jumped to a one-run lead in the first inning. The Seminoles came back in the third with four runs on four hits and an infield error.

The Teacher's top hitter was right fielder Dan Stite, who singled in the tying run in fourth inning and doubled in the win-

ning tally in the sixth.

The Seminoles threatened again in the ninth frame with one out and men on first and second. But Clyde Miller replaced Ray Mims on the mound and proceeded to strike out one man and forced the next batter to ground out.

Leading FSU hitter was first baseman Charlie Rodgers, who collected a double and two singles in four trips.

This gives FSU a 16-9 record for the season.

The Seminoles will play Georgia at Athens on Monday and Tuesday and will wind up their 1959 season at Auburn, Wednesday and Thursday.
