

DAVIS pitched perfect ball for four innings and blanked the Bulldogs through eight frames to notch his sixth victory against two losses. Litwhiler rested Davis in the ninth inning, when Georgia scored its only runs off relief pitcher Al Zyla.

Davis may get the call to face Auburn in one of two games against the Plainsmen at Auburn Wednesday and Thursday.

Key blows were bases-loaded singles by third baseman Jack Dull and leftfielder John King, and a bases-filled double by Catcher Bill Westendick.

Dull, King, second baseman Bob Clem and rightfielder Neil Martin led a 12-hit FSU attack with two safeties each.

Dull drove home two runs to tie an all-time Seminole RBI record. The Tallahassee sophomore now has 29 RBIs, tying him with All-America shortstop Dick Howser, who batted in 29 runs in 1957.

Clem, Atlanta sophomore, hitting a record pace (.463), needs only two hits in the final three games to tie a record of most hits in a single campaign (38 in 1956).

Besides getting two hits, Martin drew three walks to run his season total of free passes to 27, tying a mark set by Lee Corse in 1957.

Davis didn't walk a man and fanned seven in his eight-inning shutout stint. First baseman Phil Ashe batted in Georgia's two runs off Zyla in the ninth.

Georgia, which has a combined record of 11-17, is having its first losing season since Jim Whatley became coach in 1952. The Seminoles, who still have a shot at a District 3 NCAA tournament at-large bid, have an overall record of 17-9.

With today's game and a pair at Auburn, the Tribe is aiming at its fourth straight season of 20 or more victories under Litwhiler.
