

Florida State's solid-hitting baseball nine bounced back from an earlier defeat by Auburn to subdue the Tigers, 22-8, at Seminole Field yesterday.

The final game in the three-game series is set for 3:30 today with sophomore lefthander Ray McNamee due to pitch for the Seminoles.

Victims of big innings in their previous two games, the Seminoles came up with some multiple-run misery for Auburn yesterday. The Tribe scored six runs as 10 men came to bat in the third inning and sent 18 batters to the plate in a nine-run seventh inning.

The Seminoles combined 14 hits, nine Auburn walks, five Tiger errors, and seven stolen bases for their biggest run total since 1956.

Nine Seminoles joined in the hit parade with centerfielder Bob Glan getting a triple and three singles. Team captain Ray Russell smacked a triple and home run—his second in as

from Miami, picked up his third victory of the young season, allowing nine hits and four runs in the seven innings he worked. Davis has three of the four FSU triumphs this season. The Tribe has lost two.

The Seminoles had Auburn in trouble early, stealing five bases in a three-run first inning. Highlight was a delayed double steal, with first baseman John Elation safe at second and left-fielder Gene McCormick stealing home.

Centerfield Larry Nichols paced Auburn with a double and two singles. Starting pitcher Bob Baker was the loser.
