

**STATESBORO, Ga. —** Hoping to bounce back from a Friday loss to Georgia, Florida State's baseballers take on tough Georgia Southern College in a doubleheader here today.

Georgia experimented with a new infield combination at Athens yesterday and it paid off with an 11-0 victory over the Seminoles. The loss halted a four-game FSU winning streak and provided the overdue Bulldogs with their first 1960 triumph after five losses.

The Tribe had whacked Georgia, 10-1 and 9-2, in earlier games this season.

FSU outhit the Bulldogs, 12-11, yesterday, but Georgia bunched eight of its runs in its last three turns at bat to overcome a 2-2 Seminole lead.

Bob Gagle was the winner for Georgia in relief of Max Staples. Sophomore Ray McShane, who had control problems, was tagged with the loss.

Shortstop Joey Miller led Georgia's 11-hit attack with a double and two singles. He had three runs-batted-in.

Seven Seminoles collected two

hits apiece with soph rightfielder Jimmy White getting a home run and single in three trips.

FSU, which pulled off its 12th double play in 19 games, now has a 7-2 record.
