

With junior Frank Davis' sixth straight victory tucked away, Florida State's baseball Seminoles move after their 10th triumph of the season against Mississippi College today.

Jim Daniel, two-spot stand-out from Atlanta, was set to pitch in the Tribe's final game with the Choctaws from Clinton, Miss.

The Seminoles grabbed yesterday's series opener, 4-2, behind Davis' neat seven-hitter. The unbeaten Miami junior fanned six, walked one, and was in hot water in only one inning.

Mississippi College bunched three hits in the fifth inning to tie the game at 2-2 on pitcher Lamont Echols' two-out single to left.

The Seminoles had taken a 1-0 lead in the third inning on an error, Davis' sacrifice, an infield out, and a wild pitch. FSU made it 2-0 in the fourth when center-fielder Bob Clem singled to center, stole second, and scored on first baseman Doug Walker's single past the shortstop.

Mississippi College's two-run first hit in the Tribe pushed scored what proved to be the winning run in the sixth. Walker singled and raced to third on catcher Jack Stone's single to left. A pitch got away from the catcher and when he threw past Stone, scoring at home, Walker raced in from third.

... an error, and right-fielder Doug Walker's line single scored past FSU an insurance run in the seventh.

... Stone had two hits and Clem getting the game's only extra base blow, a home run center in the first inning.

... first baseman Paul Sullivan and left baseman H. T. Bushy each collected two singles for the loss.

The game was played in two hours and two minutes, fastest nine-inning collegiate game of the season here.

FSU now has an 8-3 record against college nines and a 9-5 chart overall. The Seminoles open a two-game series with tough Florida Southern here tomorrow.
