

Sophomore lefthander Ray McShane was scheduled to pitch here today as Florida State's baseball nine sought to snap a two-game losing streak in a series finale with Florida Southern College.

Late this morning two FSU games scheduled with Florida at Gainesville for Friday and Saturday were postponed because of the death of President Robert Strozler. Memorial services will be held at FSU for Strozler on Friday and the funeral is Saturday.

The games will be played May 9, 10.

A track meet with Florida at Gainesville, scheduled for Saturday, has been moved to Monday.

Florida Southern yesterday parlayed seven hits with 12 Seminole walks to take the series opener, 11-4. It was the 16th victory in 19 games for Florida Southern. FSU has a 9-6 season record.

The Mocs jumped off to a five-run start in the first inning on a single, six walks, and a hit batsmen. FSU narrowed the gap to 5-4 with a four-run outburst in the second. The rally was triggered by relief pitcher Jerry Hohne's two-out, bases-loaded triple to right.

The Mocs scored twice more without a hit in the sixth inning, and chased across their final four runs on two hits, three

walks, and three FSU errors in the eighth.

FSU outhit the visitors, 10-7, but Florida Southern lefthander Brad Dinamore was tough with men on base. Getting his seventh win in nine decisions, Dinamore walked three and struck out 12. Eleven FSU runners were stranded.

Shortstop Jay Gould had two of the Mocs' seven hits. Centerfielder Bob Clem and shortstop Ernie Lanford each had two hits for the Tribe.

Senior rightlander Carl Nelson, who retired only one man, was the loser. Hohne was sharp in relief, allowing only one hit and two unearned runs in 5½ innings.

Three Seminole double plays erased other Florida Southern threats.
