**AUBURN, Ala.**—Weather permitting, Florida State's baseball nine hoped to salvage the final game of a two-game series with Auburn's Tigers here today.

Auburn won yesterday's rained-shortened opener, scoring four times in the last of the seventh inning for a 4-3 verdict over the Seminoles. The game was called with Auburn at bat in the eighth and the score reverted to the seventh inning.

FSU took a 3-0 lead in the fifth inning on Bob Clem's solo home run, a double by third baseman Jack Dull, and singles by shortstop Ernie Lanford and catcher Bill Westendick.

Auburn rallied for four big runs in the seventh. Two walks, an error, and three singles pushed across four runs. Victim was FSU righthander Frank Davis, who relieved starter Jim Daniel with the bases filled. The deciding run was Davis' responsibility and tagged him with his third straight loss after six wins.

Bob Baker was the winning pitcher, allowing five hits, two by Dull.

FSU has a 9-8 record against collegiate teams. Auburn and FSU have split four games this season.
