

Florida, still atop the SEC Eastern Division, has a 15-11 season record.

For the second straight day, the Seminoles out-hit their hosts. FSU bagged 14 hits, with Bazzell getting four and Jimmy White, Jack Dull, and Hank Ross contributing two each.

Leading 13-6 after 7½ innings, FSU called on ace pitcher Frank Davis to put out a Gator rally in the eighth. With five runs across and the lead trimmed to two runs, Davis got Gator catcher Paul Booher to foul to the catcher on his first pitch in relief of Jerry Hohne. He tamed the Gators in the ninth with no damage.

Starter Jim Daniel was credited with his second win against one loss, although he surrendered six runs in five innings.

Florida jumped off to a 3-0 lead in the first inning on a walk, Leon Dorsett's double, and outfielder Don Fleming's two-run homer. FSU went ahead, 4-3, on a walk, an error, and singles by Ross, Daniel, Bazzell, and White after two were out in the second.

Florida tied it in the third on a home run by first baseman Ron Overcash and scored two more in the fifth on a walk, two errors and two singles.

FSU took the lead for good with five runs in the sixth. Two infield errors and singles by Jack Dull, Ross, Bazzell, and White chased Florida starter Rickie Smith, the loser. Four singles and a walk gave FSU a 12-6 margin in the seventh.

The Seminoles scored their 13th run before Florida rallied for five runs in the eighth.

The series sweep cut Florida's edge in the state rivalry to seven games to four, and kept alive all FSU chances of gaining a fifth straight NCAA district playoff invitation.
