Yesterday's victory lifted FSU's season record to 5-1 and the Seminoles have come from behind to win four of them.

Navy grabbed a 6-0 lead and led, 8-2, going into the seventh inning.

The Seminoles exploded for six runs to tie the score and then won it in the ninth.

In FSU's big seventh, two errors and a walk loaded the bases. Outfielder Bob Madison singled home two runs. Pinch-hitter Harold Mangin's infield single loaded the bases again. Doug Walker hit into a force play and Jack Dull walked.

Then Jimmy White, out since the opening game with a fot injury, chased two more runs in with a pinch single. Doug French tran for White and Dull stole home for the tying run as French was caught in a run-down between first and second on a delayed double tisteal attempt.

The Tribe scored the winning run with two out in the ninth. A hit batsman and three straight walks forced in Gary Elliott with the clincher.

to get the win. Bruce Gunkle,
