

**JACKSONVILLE** — Overcoming a six-run deficit in the last three innings, Florida State's baseball team pushed across the deciding run in the top of the ninth for a 9-8 decision over Navy's Midshipmen here yesterday.

The teams conclude a two-game series here today, with Jim Daniel set to pitch for FSU.

Yesterday's victory lifted FSU's season record to 5-1 and the Seminoles have come from behind to win four of them.

Navy grabbed a 6-0 lead and led, 8-2, going into the seventh inning.

The Seminoles exploded for six runs to tie the score and then won it in the ninth.

In FSU's big seventh, two errors and a walk loaded the bases. Outfielder Bob Madison singled home two runs. Pinch-hitter Harold Mangin's infield single loaded the bases again. Doug Walker hit into a force play and Jack Dull walked.

Then Jimmy White, out since the opening game with a foot injury, chased two more runs in with a pinch single. Doug French ran for White and Dull stole home for the tying run as French was caught in a run-down between first and second on a delayed double steal attempt.

The Tribe scored the winning run with two out in the ninth. A hit batsman and three straight walks forced in Gary Elliott with the clincher.

Jerry Turner held Navy scoreless in 3 2/3 innings of relief to get the win. Bruce Gunkle, last of three Navy pitchers, was the loser.

Joe Bellino, Navy's All-America halfback now catching with the Middies, was held hitless in three trips.
