Righthander Jim Daniel was a pitching and batting feature in yesterday's triumph. The lanky senior tamed the Blue Devils on five hits over eight innings and drove in three first-inning runs with a base-clearing double.

Scoring in the first inning for the third straight game, FSU used singles by outfielders Jimmy White and Bob Madison and first baseman Doug Walker, two walks, a hit batsman, and Daniel's twobagger for a seven-run start.

Duke picked up single runs in the second and third innings but Daniel and John Tucker, who pitched the ninth inning, held the Blue Devils scoreless the rest of the way.

The Seminoles picked up a fifth-inning run on catcher Buddy Teagle's triple and an infield error.
