

LAKELAND—Shelling three Florida Southern pitchers for 18 hits, Florida State's red-hot baseball team won its fifth straight game and 16th of the season, 13-2, here yesterday.

Bidding for an NCAA tournament invitation, Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles have dropped only four of 20 games. FSU is the nation's sixth-ranked college nine.

Senior pitcher Jim Daniel spaced out 11 hits in notching his fifth triumph against one loss. The lanky righthander walked only one and struck out eight.

HIT PARADE

Eleven Seminoles joined in the hit parade against Southern's Chuck Anderson, Ken Smedley, and Tony Braddock. Third baseman George Fergusson had three

hits, singling his first three trips to the plate.

Litwhiler used 14 players, as FSU dumped the Moccasins for the second straight day.

The Seminoles wrapped it up early, scoring five runs in the first inning on a walk, two Southern errors, and four singles.

Second baseman Jack Dull, centerfielder Bob Madison, and reserve infielder Doug French each doubled for FSU, which stole four bases.

The Seminoles hope to continue their streak in the opener of a two-game series at Miami Monday. Frank Davis (3-1) is the FSU pitching choice.
