

ATHENS, Ga.—Florida State's surging baseball team bunched all its runs into two innings to turn back Georgia, 5-3, here yesterday.

It was the eighth straight triumph—seven in a row away from home—for Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles, who have a season record of 19-4.

Senior All-America Jack Dull was the batting hero, driving in two runs with a sacrifice fly and a double. Outfielders Jimmy White and Gary Elliott each had two hits for FSU, outhit by the Bulldogs, 10-7.

Pitching the distance was senior Frank Davis, who picked up his 21st career victory for FSU. Davis, who walked four and fanned five, is 5-1 this season.

Senior Jim Daniel (6-1) was the probable Seminole pitcher in the finale of a two-game series today.

The Seminoles used a walk to Neil Martin, singles by White and Doug Walker, and Dull's long sacrifice fly for two first-inning runs. They scored three more in the seventh on two walks, a double by Dull, and singles by Elliott and third baseman George Fergusson.

Georgia got a single run in the second inning and scored its final

two runs in the ninth inning.

Losing pitcher was lefthander John Nuckolls, who got into trouble because of 10 walks. Davis was tough in the clutch as Georgia left 13 runners stranded.

FSU now has won three in a row over the Bulldogs this season and leads in the all-time series with Georgia, 16-10.
