

**ATHENS, Ga.**—Georgia first baseman Buddy Scott socked two home runs and helped break Florida State's 8-games baseball winning streak in a 10-9 decision here yesterday.

Three unearned runs in the bottom of the eighth overcame a 2-run FSU lead.

The loss left the Seminoles with a 19-5 record, was the first setback in four games with the Georgians this season. FSU won Friday's game here, 5-3.

Seven of the Tribe's eight consecutive triumphs came on the road.

Scott clouted a grand slam in the fourth inning, slapped a 2-run circuit-blow in his next time at bat in the sixth. They were the first homers of his varsity career.

Scott went 3-for-4 to lead both teams.

Bob Madison's double was FSU's only extra base blow. Jimmy White, Jack Dull and Roger Zimmerman had two hits apiece.

Jack Ross was the loser. He

relieved starter Jim Daniel in the seventh frame.

The Bulldogs used two singles, a pass ball and an error for the three decisive runs.

Each team committed five miscues afield.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's club goes into a 2-weeks rest before resuming its schedule in a home series with Georgia Southern on May 8-9.
