

Getting high efficiency out of nine hits, Florida State's baseball team rolled over Georgia, 13-3, in an opening game for both teams here yesterday afternoon.

Rain, which fell during the late innings Wednesday, may cancel this afternoon's 3:30 second game between the two.

The Seminoles are scheduled to play Auburn here tomorrow (3:30) and Saturday (1:30).

#### EIGHT PITCHERS

Trying to get in as much work as possible during a 4-day Florida swing, Georgia Coach Jim

Whatley used a pitcher per inning yesterday. The Bulldogs play at Florida tomorrow and Saturday.

Whatley's first seven pitchers did well enough. FSU scored six runs off the seven — only two were earned — and held a 6-3 lead going into the bottom of the eighth.

Then the Seminoles "worked over" Whatley's eighth choice, soph righthander Charles Bagby, son of former major league pitcher Jim Bagby. Two triples — including William Woodward's smash with the bases loaded — plus a single and three bases on balls and an error did the damage as FSU tallied seven runs, all earned.

FSU got a 3-0 jump in the first inning, on a single, a walk and two errors.

Georgia pecked away for single runs in the second, sixth and eighth innings, with Joey Miller driving in two with a pair of triples to deep center. FSU got lone runs in the fifth, sixth and seventh, one coming on senior centerfielder Bob Madison's homer.

#### TOP HITTERS

Madison, with a single and homer, and leftfielder Dwight Smith, with two singles, were the only Seminoles with more than one hit. Miller's two triples and a pair of singles by Paul Wal-drop represented the bulk of Georgia's seven hits.

Lefthander Ray McShane pitched the distance for FSU, walking just two, striking out three.
