

Florida State's baseball team broke loose for three runs in the eighth inning, snapping a 3-3 tie and beating Georgia, 6-3, here yesterday afternoon.

The Seminoles, now 2-0 after a sweep of the opening series with the Bulldogs, take on Auburn here today and tomorrow. Today's game was scheduled for 3:30 p. m., tomorrow's at 1:30 p. m.

Jack Ross, senior lefthander, was due to start against Auburn today, seeking to become the third straight FSU pitcher to go the distance.

ALL THE WAY

Larry Hawkins, tall (6-4) right-hander who came to the Tribe from a junior college, rationed six hits to Georgia in going the full nine yesterday. He walked two batters, struck out four.

Georgia stepped to a 1-0 lead in the second on a single and Tommy Vandiver's double. FSU tied it in the third on Gary Elliott's single and Buddy Teagle's double. The Seminoles went a run ahead in the fifth on Teagle's homer.

Then FSU stretched the lead

to 3-1 on the sixth when Bob Madison singled, moved to second on a grounder, and scored on Woodie Woodward's single.

Georgia tied it in the top of the eighth. Mike Pickett lived on an error. Paul Waldrop singled. Pickett scored as Walt Strong grounded out, forcing Waldrop. Benny Cheek and Bob Sapp followed with singles, scoring Strong.

Bob Madison walked to start FSU's eruption in the bottom of the eighth. Dwight Smith attempted a sacrifice, and all hands were safe on the shortstop's error. Billy Williamson tripled to left, scoring two. Williamson scored when pitcher Strong fumbled Harold Mangin's grounder.

TEAGLE TOPS

Strong was the losing pitcher, in relief of starter John Wyatt, son of former major leaguer Whitlow Wyatt.

Teagle, with a homer, double and single, led FSU's 10-hit attack. Elliott and Madison got two hits apiece.
