

FSU plays a doubleheader in Jacksonville tomorrow, against Navy and Jacksonville University.

Teagle's fly brought home Billy Williamson, star of Tuesday's victory. Williamson reached second on a 2 - base error by Georgia Tech football star Billy Williamson.

Hal Mangin singled to left, and Williamson chose to hold, but moved down to third when Tech third basemen Mickie Carmack booted Bob Wilcox' grounder.

Teagle's 2-run homer in the eighth had tied it at 5-5. It brought in Mangin, whose double had drove in Woody Woodward. Jack Ross followed Teagle's homer with a double and Kyle Spitzer singled to right driving in Ross and to make it, 6-5.

Tech came back to tie it up in the ninth, after pitcher Ross got the first two batters out. Williamson singled to center, went to second on a wild pitch and Dick Conliff, who went 3-for-5, drove him home with the tying run.
