Furman pushed across three runs in the second inning, putting together five singles and an FSU error.

Pickens' triple brought in a 4th-inning score. Four base hits brought across a fifth-inning tally. Mason's double accounted for a 6th inning run, and Fred Hasher's double brought in an 8th-inning score.

FSU used four singles and an error by Furman for its two runs in the third.
