

Pitcher Larry Hawkins' fine show at the plate helped lift Florida State's baseball team to a 21-9 victory over Furman here yesterday.

The game was called in the eighth inning because of darkness. It was the first loss of the season for the South Carolinians, winners over FSU in a Monday game. Furman had won three.

It brought the Seminoles' record 8-3 for the year.

Hawkins, a lanky righthander, collected a double and home run in four trips. His record is 2-0.

Sophomore shortstop Woody Woodward of FSU increased his hitting string to 11 consecutive games. He collected two singles in five trips.

Another hitting star for the Seminoles was sophomore Bob Wilcox, who came in in the sixth inning and collected three straight hits.

FSU chalked up a total of 18 hits. Furman got itself 16, led by shortstop Charles Jennings with two singles and a double in four attempts.

Gaines Mason, Paladin centerfielder, went 3-for-5 for the second straight day. He bashed an 8th-inning triple that drove in two runs.

FSU pushed across two runs in each of the first two innings, capped the production with five runs in the seventh.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles take the rest of the week off, play at Auburn Monday and Tuesday. Auburn is responsible for two of FSU's three losses.
